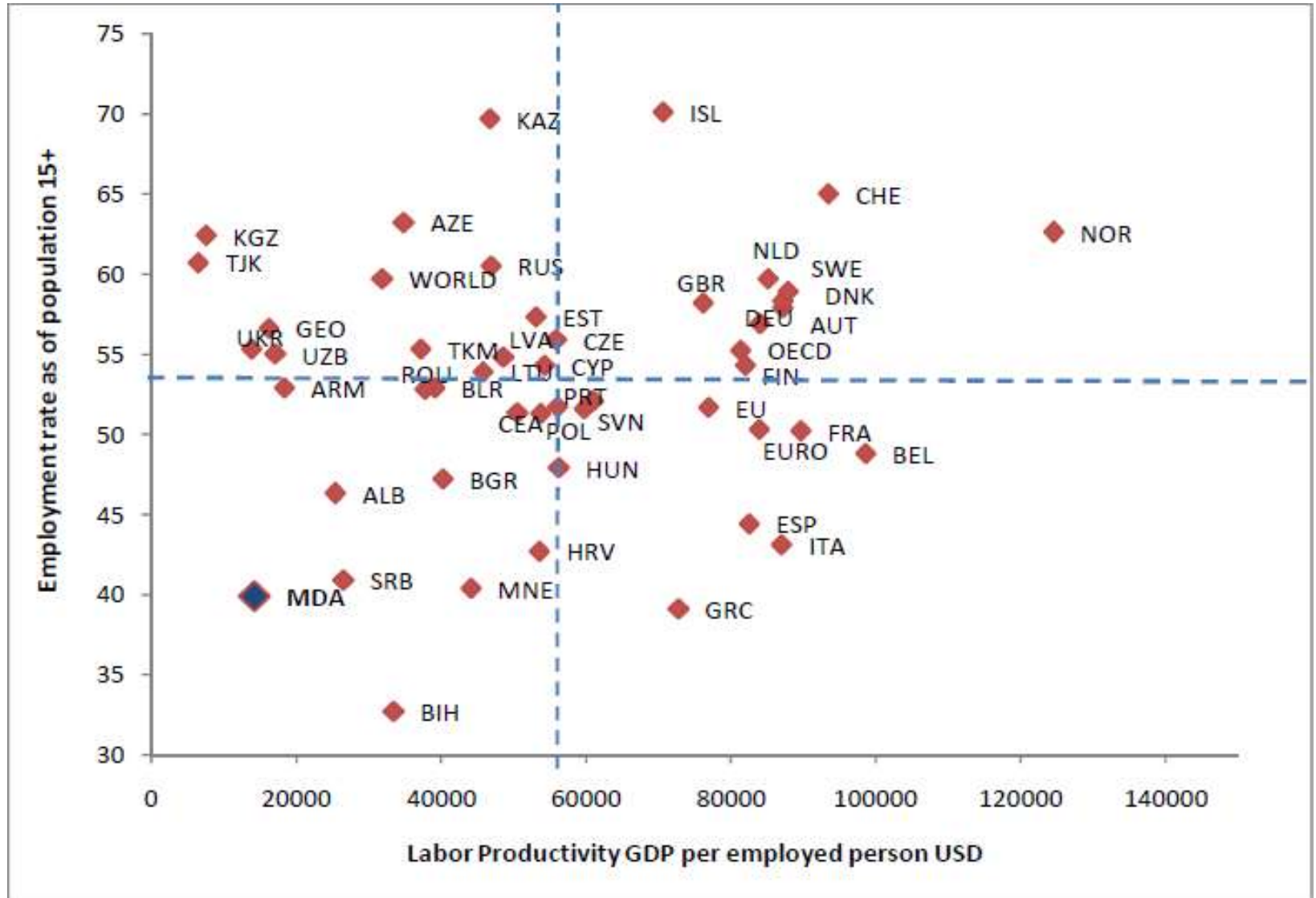


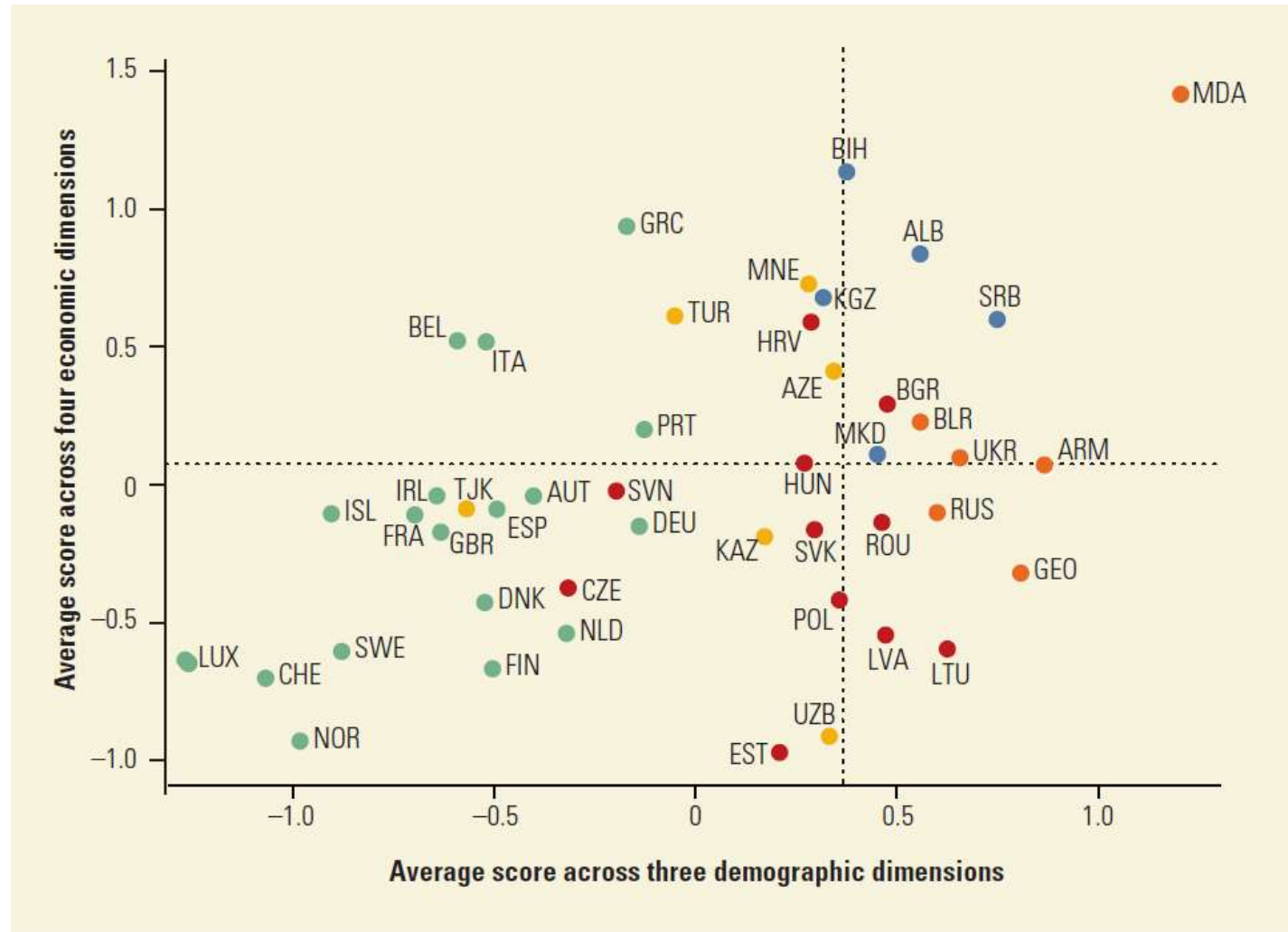

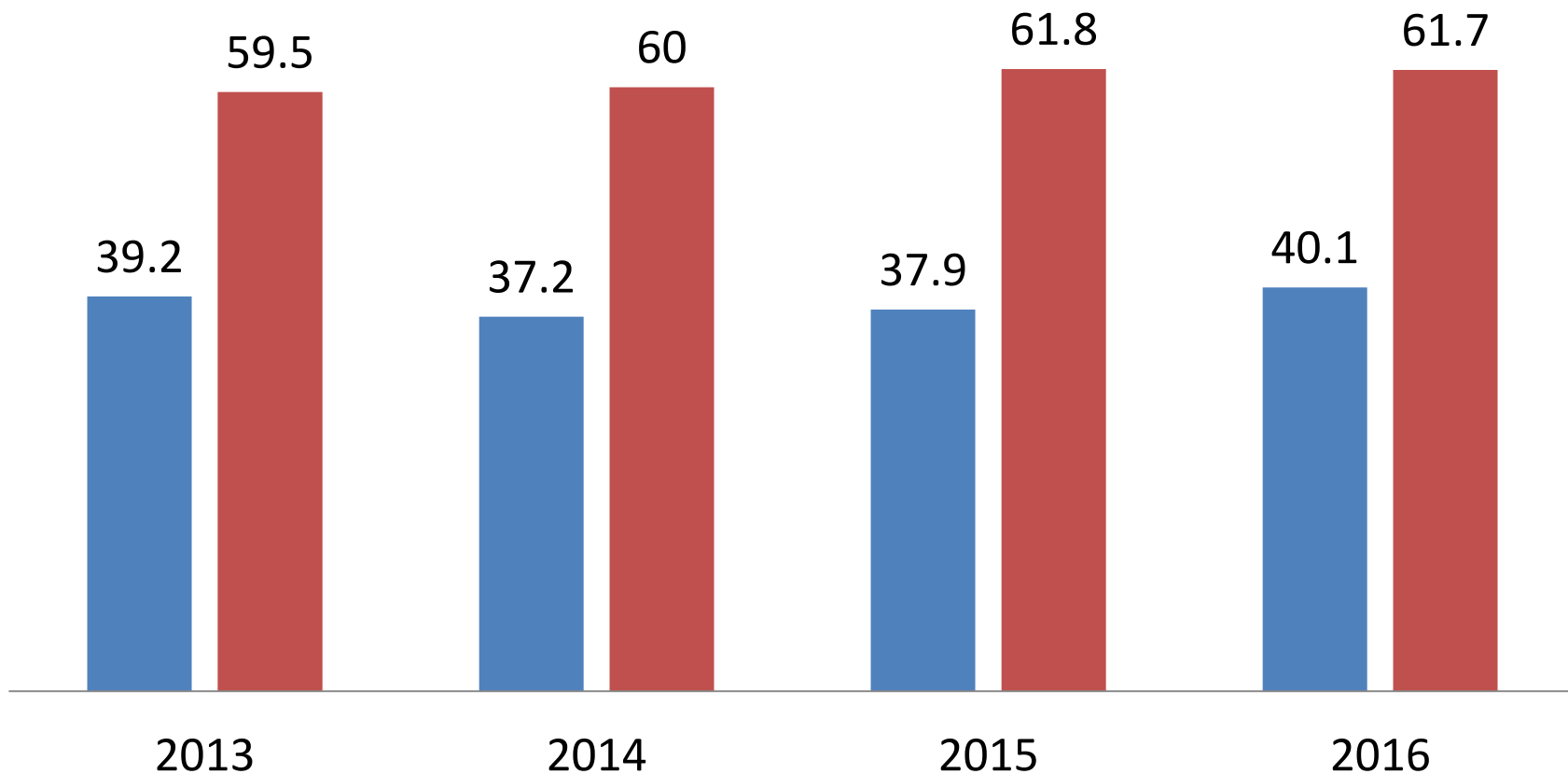


Demographic outlook

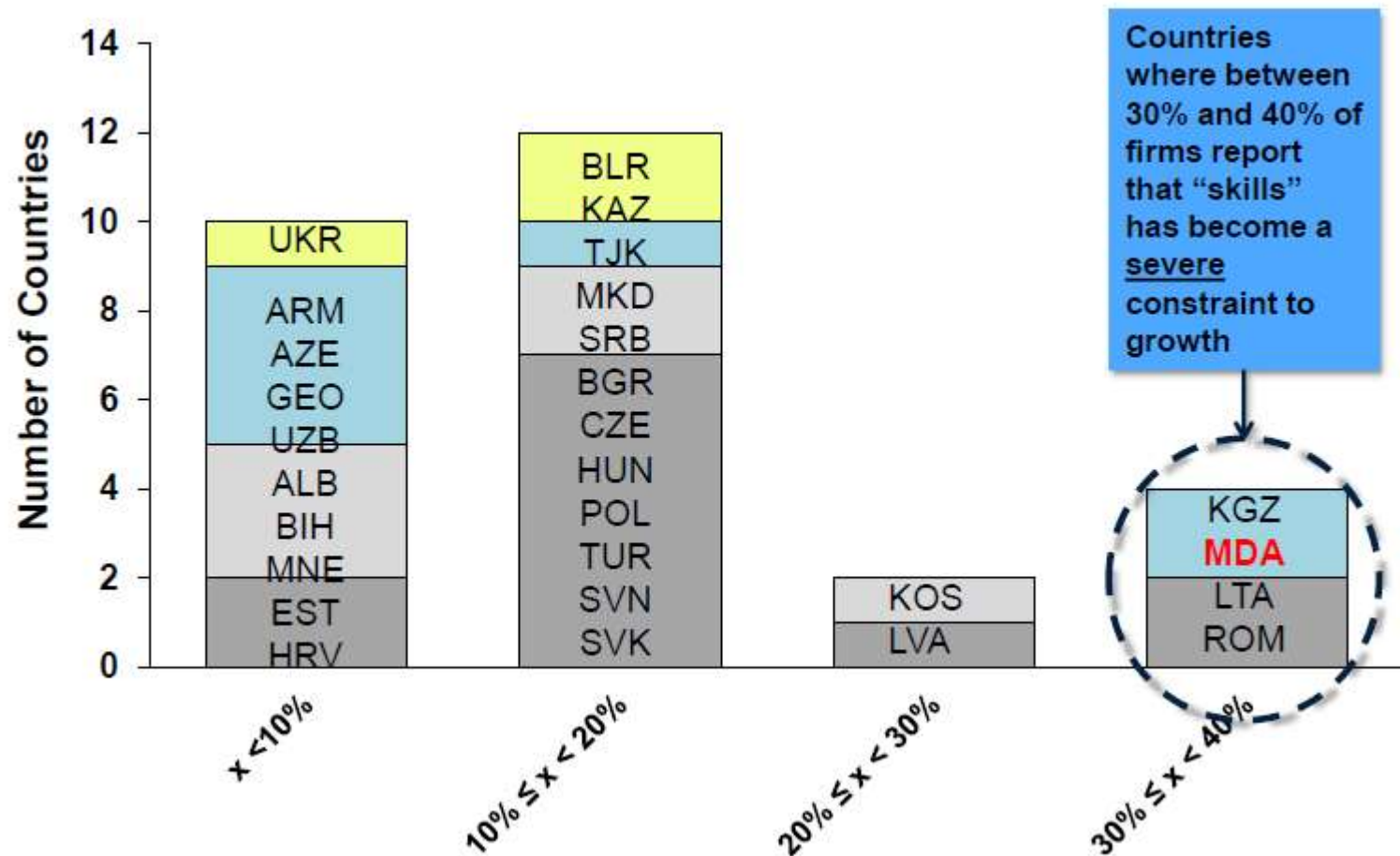


Employment of women (25-49)

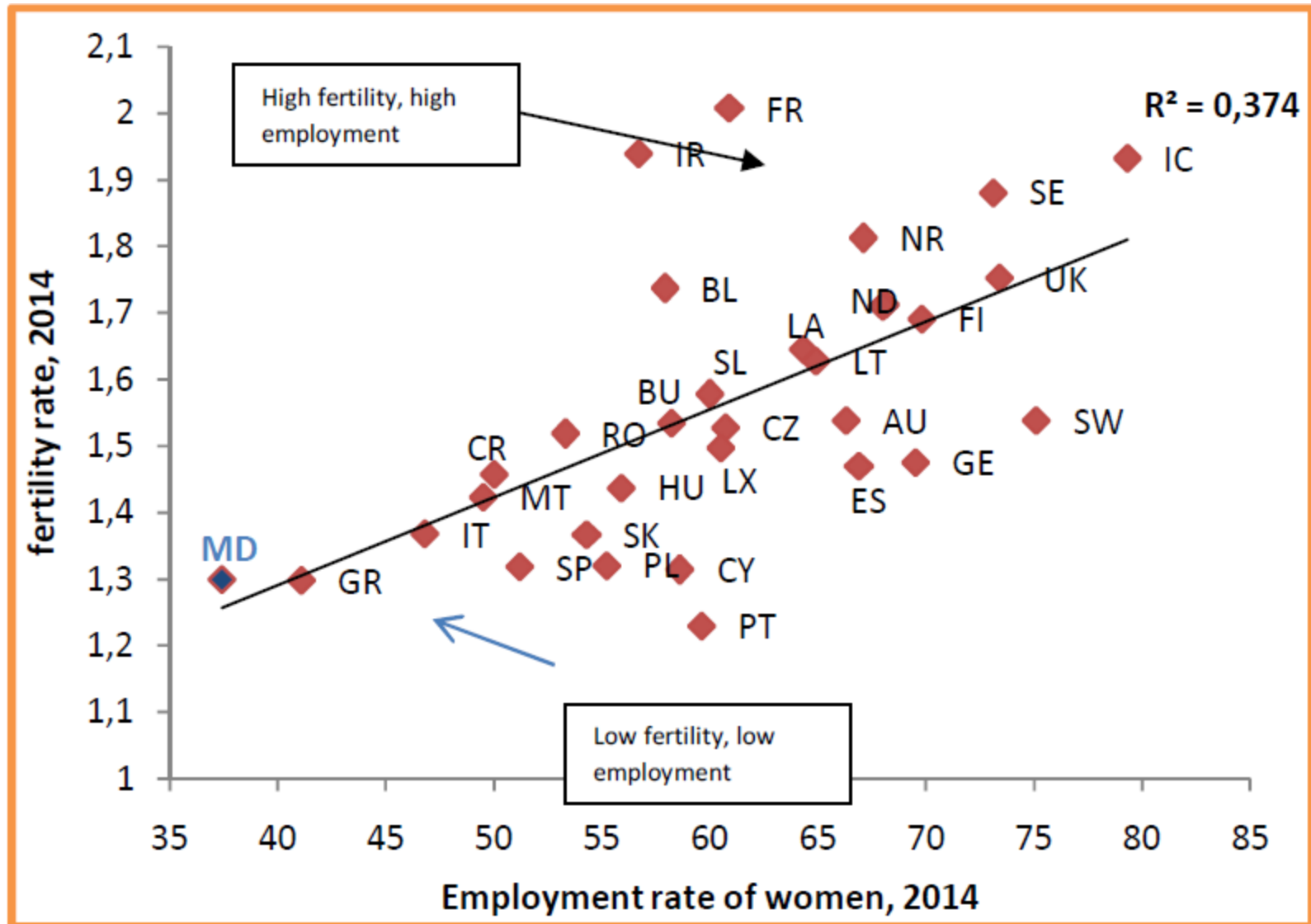
■ with at least one preschool age child ■ no child of preschool age

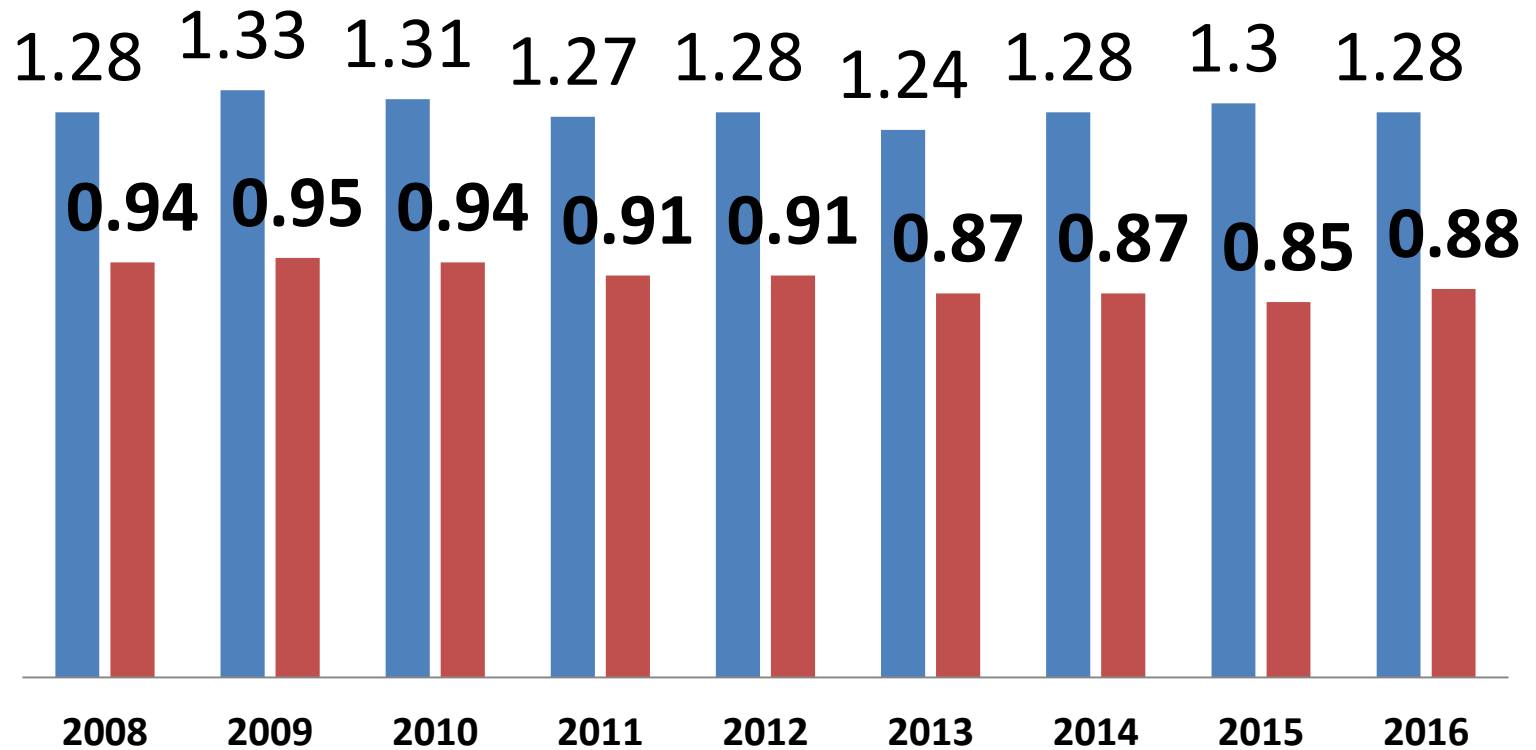


Employment & Fertility



More job opportunities lower fertility

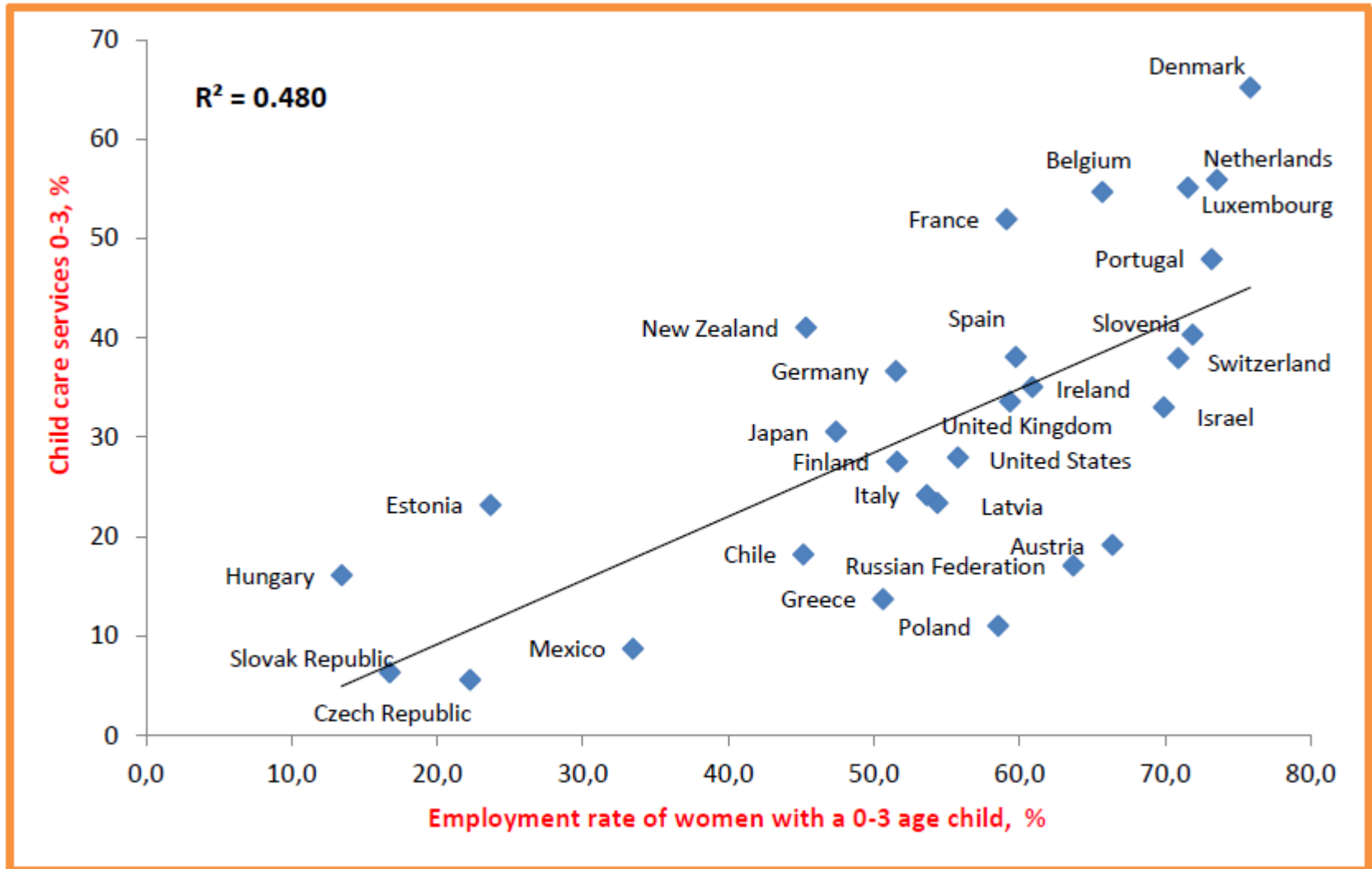

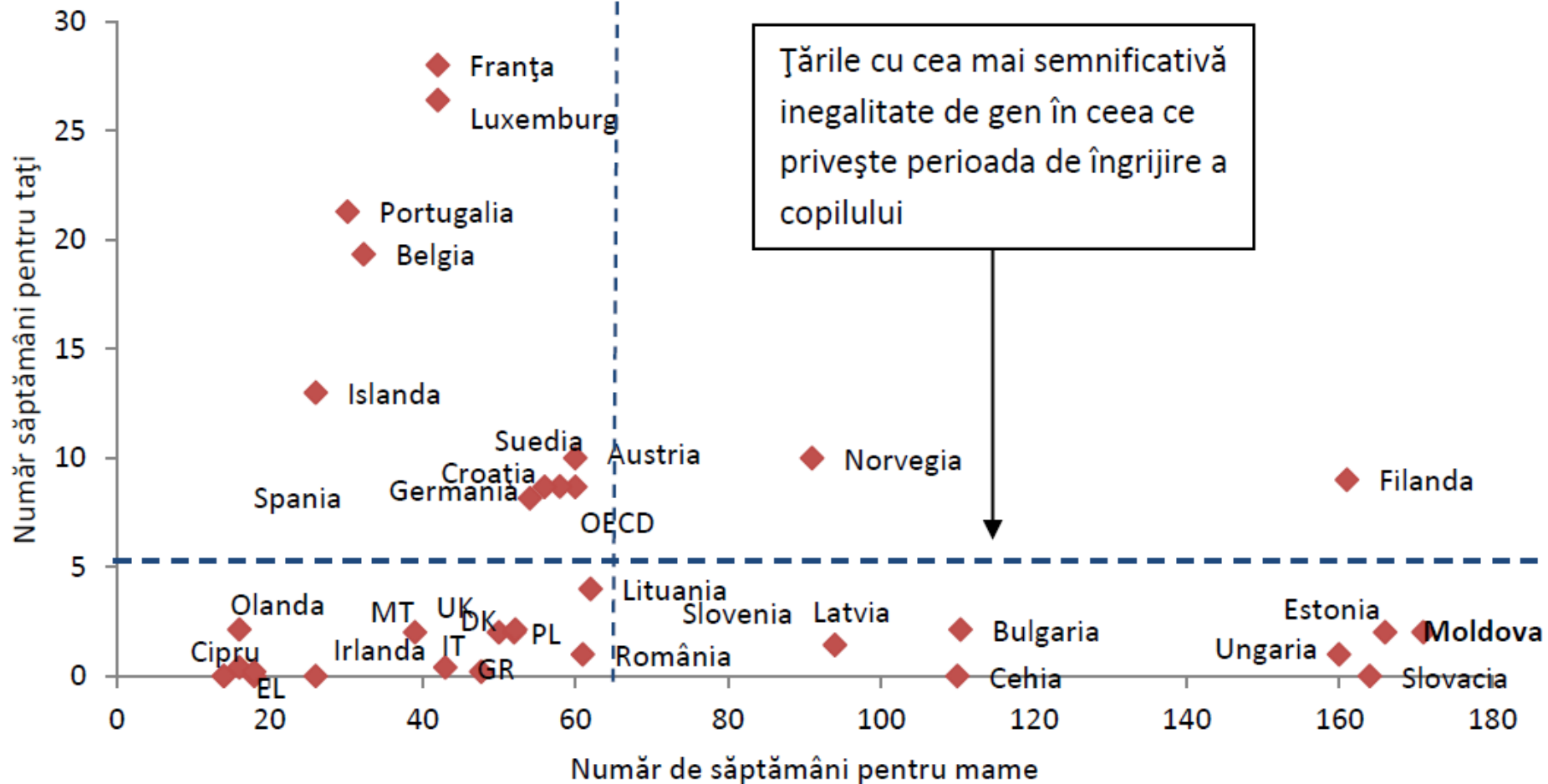
Unequal distribution of care responsibilities (hours)



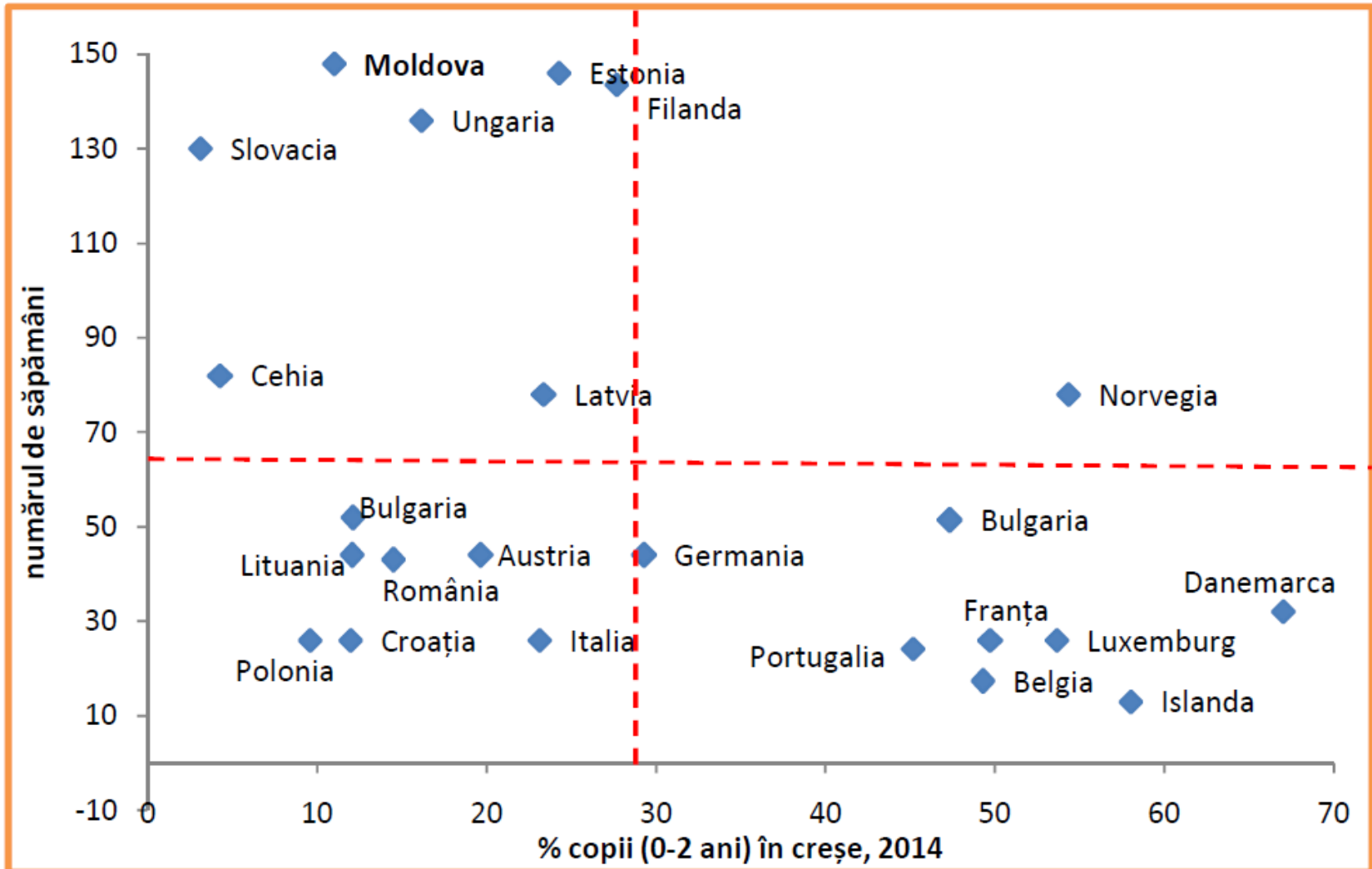

This paper examines the quantitative effects of gender gaps in entrepreneurship and workforce participation. We simulate an occupational choice model with heterogeneous agents in entrepreneurial ability.
