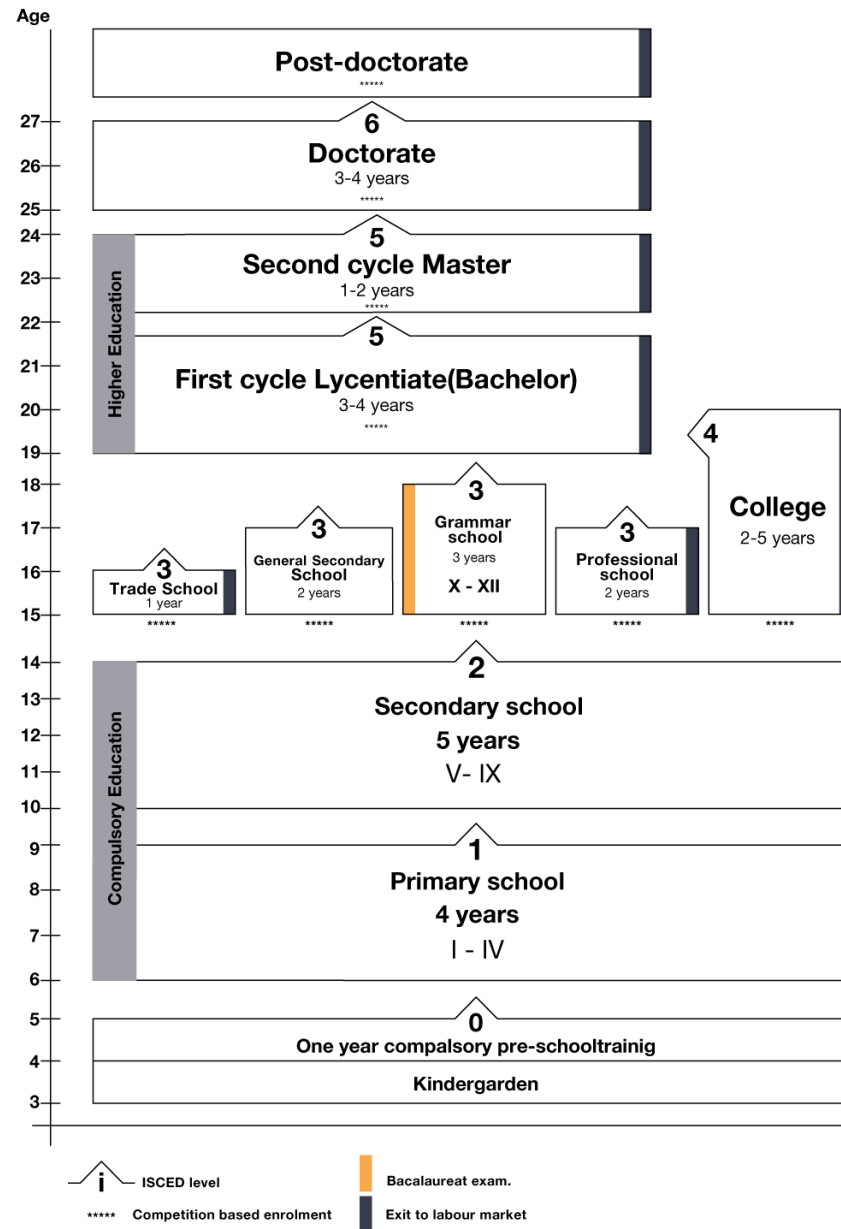

Education system

A PRIORITY FOR MOLDOVA

- ▶ Education Code
- ▶ Reanimation of vocational technical training through dual education (Regulation approved through GD)
- ▶ A series of Action Plans and Strategies for different education levels
- ▶ Proposals developed by Ministry of Education on upgrading tertiary education
- ▶ Centers of excellence opened to boost certain types of specialties



Priority actions to consider to upgrade the education system in Moldova

- ▶ Mismatch in terms of investors requirements and policy making process – strategic (5-10 years) approach to education;
- ▶ Lack of consistency between investment plans and dynamics at the regional level with the types of specialties needed in a 5-10 years frame;
- ▶ The education curricula is out graded and does not respond to the needs of investors;
- ▶ Lack of a merit based financing mechanism at all education levels;
- ▶ Lack of consistency between general/average/tertiary education.
- ▶ Upgrade the nomenclature of professions;
